Discussion regarding the Proposition 2 ½ and post override expenditures. Selectman Cochrane said she had questions regarding positions and why we funded things we didn't know about as a Board. What happens if we had a position and then didn't use it the money goes in to free cash? She felt that the meeting before was premature. Mr. Coutinho stated that he is confused on the budget process as well. He has not seen it done this way before. He and the Town Accountant went over this. There was a lack of communication and he does not feel that the Finance Committee fully understands what their role is supposed to be. They are an advisory committee to the Town Meeting. By Town ByLaw they have a right to make recommendations to Town Meeting. If the Finance Committee does go forward with their recommendation there is nothing that is said that the Selectmen or any other elected board will agree to spend or agree to what they want to do. Cochrane stated that she felt it would make more sense to hash these things out before the Town meeting and go in as a united front rather than have these things on hold. She thinks that everyone should have an informed vote, but she doesn't want people to think anyone lied if they decided not to spend money somewhere. Mr. Coutinho also stated that they cannot just say that the Town Hall is going to be opened different hours now when that is actually a change in working conditions that has to be bargained you can't just arbitrarily that an employee in the union that they are going to start working at 8am, that needs to be bargained. Miller doesn't think it was done in bad faith, but we are not there yet. Cochrane feels that the information being put out to the residents was not accurate. The Board agreed that the Finance Committee and the Selectmen's should have a joint meeting to discuss some of the issues. The Board would like to schedule a joint meeting for the following Monday, May 7, 2018 if possible.

There needs to be a body that can perform the basic duties and also access to the tools they need to perform the basic duties. Cochrane noted that for the past six weeks one of the Town's employees has been trying to run the department all alone and struggling. Mr. Coutinho stated that we are almost to the point where we should consider having someone that is trained to do some floating work to cover vacations and such.
