Miller read the following added conditions to the approval is for this Board only and does not determine if further approval is required from other Boards. Order of Conditions apply to this permit. A copy of the Order of Conditions is attached to this permit. (Attachment 'A') The provisions of the Agreement between the Town of Berkley Soil Conservation Board and Gilbert Pontes dated March 7, 2018 shall apply to this permit and are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. No soil alteration and/or removal shall be conducted for the installation of a foundation unless a valid and current foundation permit issued by the Town of Berkley Building Inspector is in effect. No soil alteration and/or removal shall be conducted for the installation of a septic system unless a valid and current Disposal System Construction Permit is in effect. This permit is granted in conformity with statues and by-laws relating thereto, and expires on August 8, 2019, unless sooner suspended or revoked. The recipient thereof may proceed to exercise the permit during the appeal period Miller then read the Standard Order of Conditions and the Agreement that was attached aloud.
