- 3. Treasurer's Report by Arlene Medeiros
  - Only change is \$500 award to Amy King from non-state funds for logo contest
  - Current balance State \$7351.14; non-state \$3929.78

- 5. Update on Farmers Market Stephanie Malloch

  - Council chooses Saturday Sept. 17<sup>th</sup> 9-1pm
  - Other thoughts from Stephanie
    - Nominal charge of \$10 "suggested donation", could use for scholarship fund etc
    - Start with produce and flowers only, as prepared foods require additional permits
    - o Promote via facebook? Angela to create such a blurb ©
    - Have banner made to announce and advertise, perhaps Amy King could create using new logo
    - Contact will be Stephanie, via a dedicated email, Angela to assist with setting that up
    - Stephanie will set up use of common with town
    - Perhaps council could find musician(s) for a little entertainment/ambiance

- 6. BCC Scholarship consideration of council sponsoring a scholarship as presented by Kelley
  - For student showing excellence in one of arts/humanities/sciences areas that council promotes
  - Perhaps start with one \$500 scholarship in one of three areas above, with possibility of growing to 3 separate scholarships one for each area in future
  - Monies would be from non-state funds, council could fundraise for
  - For graduating high school student pursuing relevant college major
  - Merit-based vs financial
  - Council has to determine how to administer, and take great care to clearly define criteria, advertise widely
  - Could have applicants submit an essay, come in for an interview, etc
  - Applicant must be a Berkley resident
  - Need to run by new town accountant for feasibility etc
  - Council members like idea, Kelley will look into further, including legal aspects further discussion at a future meeting
- 7. Advertising upcoming Grant Cycle: Arlene reports to council that council's priorities and guidelines need to be updated by Aug 31<sup>st</sup>. applications open Sept 1<sup>st</sup>, deadline is Oct 17<sup>th</sup>. New guidelines and advertising will be discussed at next meeting.
