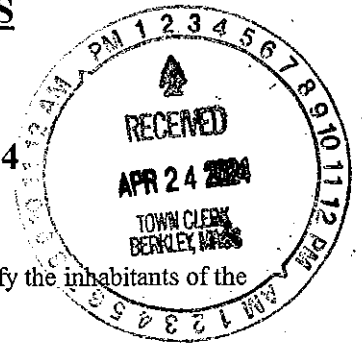

QUESTION:

Shall the Town of Berkley be allowed to exempt from the provisions of proposition two and one-half so called, the amounts required to pay for Berkley's share of the bond issued in order to fund the construction of a new Bristol-Plymouth Regional Technical School, including the payment of costs incidental and related thereto?
