The Plymouth County Sheriff's Department has contracted with Emergency Communications Network to license its CodeRED high-speed notification solution. The CodeRED system provides Plymouth County and Bristol County officials the ability to quickly deliver messages to targeted areas throughout these two counties.

WHO SHOULD REGISTER? All individuals and businesses that have:

- Unlisted phone numbers
- Changed their phone number or address within the past year
- Use a cellular phone or VoIP phone as their primary phone

WHAT INFORMATION IS NEEDED? Required information includes: name, street address (physical address, no P.O. boxes), city, state, zip code, and primary phone number. Additional phone numbers like cell, TDD/TTY devices or email may be entered as well. You must indicate your cell phone carrier to receive text messages.
