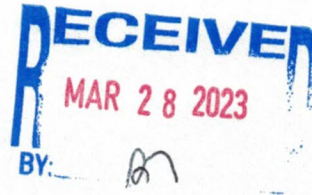

On behalf of Waste Management Disposal Services of Massachusetts (WMDSM), Geosyntec Consultants, Inc. (Geosyntec) has prepared this letter to notify you of the availability of an Immediate Response Action (IRA) Completion Report for the Disposal Site identified by Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP) Release Tracking Number (RTN) 4-25411 (the Site).
