Reopening Parts of Berkley

The Board of Selectmen along with myself would like to update our residents as to what will be open for public use now that the Governor Baker has started his Four Phase opening plan.

The public playgrounds and basketball courts at the Common and Berkley Community School will be open to the public. We are asking to adhere to the Governor's orders of no more than 10 people and to have a face covering on if you are unable to social distance. In addition to the opening of the playgrounds and courts; recycling at the Transfer Station will resume on Wednesday June 3, 2020, with some stipulations. I am attaching a copy of the notice from the Highway Department outlining how it will work. They will be opening in a 2 Phase with Phase 1 for orange bags, cardboard, plastic, paper, glass, metal, computers, TVs, leaves and brush. We are asking to have all recyclables presorted prior to arrival. You will not be allowed to sort recyclables while at the Transfer Station. Phase 2 will be posted in the near future.
