

## Berkley Advisory: Detour & 24-Hours/Day Track Work at Padelford Street

As part of the South Coast Rail Project construction, the MBTA's contractor will be working on the railroad grade crossing at Padelford Street in Berkley. This work will require the closure of Padelford Street at the crossing, and crews will be working up to 24-hours/day at the crossing. During this work, crews will be using the railroad laydown/storage area at the end of **Mill Street**.

## Padelford Street Detour: Thursday, June 23 to Monday, June 27 24-Hours/Day Work: Saturday, June 25 to Monday, June 27



All through traffic will be routed to Anthony Street, Bryant Street, and Myricks Street/Route 79. Local traffic access only on Padelford Street and Macomber Street. Signage and police details will be in place to direct local access. <u>All work is weather permitting, and dates are subject to change.</u>
