

Every year, Medicare Part D, Medigaps and Medicare Advantage (HMO, PPO) plans can change their premiums, co-pays, deductibles, formularies (list of drugs) covered) and preferred pharmacies. 

### MOMENTS FROM THE MUSEUM

This month we have a delightful photo of the Common area of Berkley. The photo below is truly unique. A lovely couple riding bikes heading toward home on North Main Street. Notice that the street is not paved. On the left side of the photo you see a small cape house with a man sitting near the front door. This house is still there today. Behind the couple you can see a forked road. To the left is Locust St and to the right is North Main Street heading toward the Berkley Dighton Bridge. There is a white building barely discernible past the trees. This is the Old Town Hall that is now used for the Berkley Historical Society Museum. What is missing in the photo is the Berkley Public Library and the reason why is because it wasn't built until 1918. The couple are riding past the Common Cemetery that cannot be seen but is on the right side of the photo. The stone wall and the white rail board fence on the left are gone and today the Boondocks Restaurant is there. A truly bucolic scene of Berkley long ago in the early 1900s. And in case you are wondering....the couple on the bicycles are Laura and Lawrence Swift and they lived at 85 No. Main St.

We invite you to visit the Berkley Historical Society Museum on Tuesdays between 10 am to 1 pm to see more items of Berkley history. The museum is located in the OLD Town Hall at 2 No. Main Street, Berkley, MA There is no admission fee.

The BHS is a non-profit organization with all volunteer staff. It is 501c3 certified and all monetary donations are tax deductible. Current and past residents will find lots of Berkley History to see. Come on by!
